



**HIGHLIGHTS**  
**REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING**  
**April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

- Commission approved an increase of the Administrative Assistant’s hourly wage by 4.1% Nova Scotia Consumer Price Index increase for December 2021 and set the Clerk Treasurer’s salary for 2022-23 at \$74,424.64.
- Commission accepted the Clerk/Treasurer, Egyedy’s “Letter of Resignation” and a Commission meeting in the next couple of days to discuss the letter.
- Commission to advertise a call for Proposals on the Flower Basket summer Maintenance.
- Commission approved the Lunenburg County Accessibility Plan as the Village of Chester guidelines to promote accessibility in the Village.
- Commission agreed to hold a Committee of the Whole meeting to discuss the Budget 2022-2023 on Wednesday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, at 1:00 pm.
- Commission approved the dates for Elections and Public Meeting as follows:

- Commission approved to issue a Request for Proposals on replacement of Tanker #551 based on equipment specifications prepared by CVFD.
- Commission approved Chair Hatch writing a letter to the Premier Houston and MLA Barkhouse opposing 2% assessment increase and distributing it to the commission for review and comments.
- Commission approved the extension of the Fire Services Agreement to July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.
- Commission approved holding a meeting with MOC to discuss the proposed fire agreement pending their dates to meet.
