Organics (Green cart)	Containers (Blue bag #1)	Paper (Blue bag #2)	Garbage (Black or clear bag)
• All food scraps (peelings, bones, seafood shells, etc.) • Paper towels & napkins • Wet or soiled paper or box board • Waxed paper • Paper dishes • Wooden stir sticks • Sawdust & wood shavings (douse with water before collection to avoid a blowing hazard) • Twigs & small brush • If your cart is full, put a maximum of 3 paper bags of leaves out per collection	• Plastic containers, tubs, lids & bottles (shampoo, yogurt, detergent, cookie trays, cleaning fluid bottles, etc.) • Aluminum foil, cans, pie plates & trays • Ice cream cartons • Cookie dough spiral cans • Glass bottles and cans • Beverage containers • Frozen juice cans • Toothpaste tubes • Deodorant containers • Plastic plant pots and seedling trays • Paper drink cups (like coffee cups)	• Newspaper & flyers • Magazines • Boxboard (paper towel & toilet paper rolls, cereal boxes, frozen food boxes, tissue boxes & shoe boxes) • File folders • Greeting cards • Egg cartons & paper trays • Pet food bags • Corrugated cardboard (flatten boxes & tie in 2' x 2' x 3' bundles & place next to other bags of recyclable paper).	• Cigarette butts • Clothing & footwear • Wallpaper • Disposable diapers • Feminine products • Kitty litter & pet waste • Vacuum bags & floor sweepings • Broken glass (place in box and label "BROKEN GLASS") • Kleenex® • Compostable plastics • Household hazardous waste must be taken directly to Kaizer Meadow in a labeled container that will not leak.

• Beverage containers (excluding milk cartons) can be returned for a refund. At participating Enviro Depots™ found at circularmaterials.ca/nsdepots: • Non-hazardous aerosol containers (hairspray, air freshener) • plastic laminates (coffee pouches; chip bags, cereal liner bags) • flexible and rigid foam (meat trays, packing peanuts). Using your phone camera, scan the QR code above to find a depot near you.	• Batteries - can be dropped off at the Municipal building(151 King Street, Chester) or the Kaizer Meadow Landfill. • Paint and empty cans - can be dropped off at the Kaizer Meadow Landfill or another recycling location found at recyclemyelectronics.ca/ns. • Medication/Syringes - return to your local pharmacy for safe disposal for free.
